

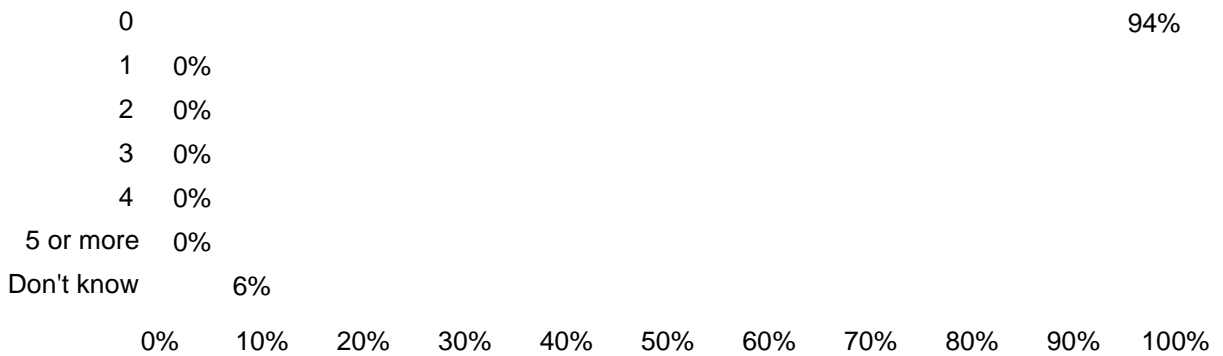
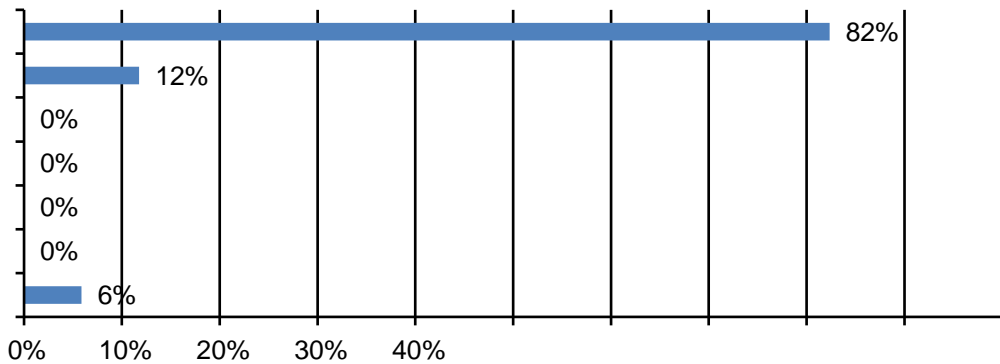

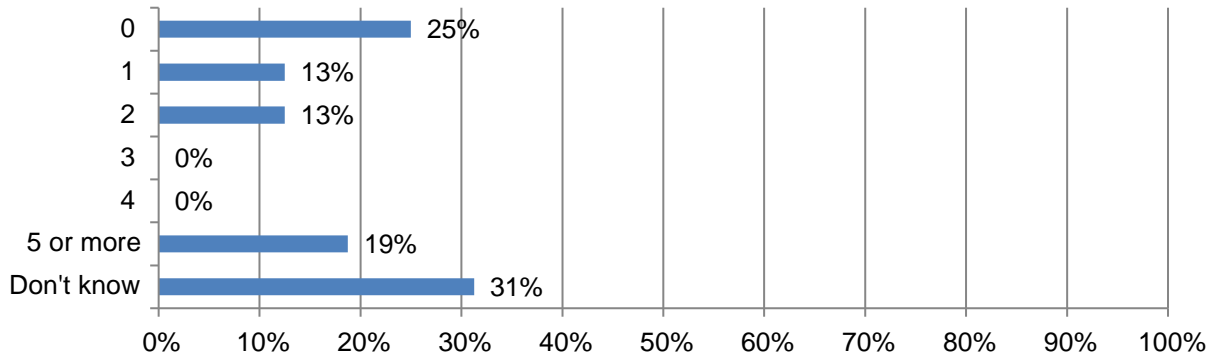

National – Northeast Results

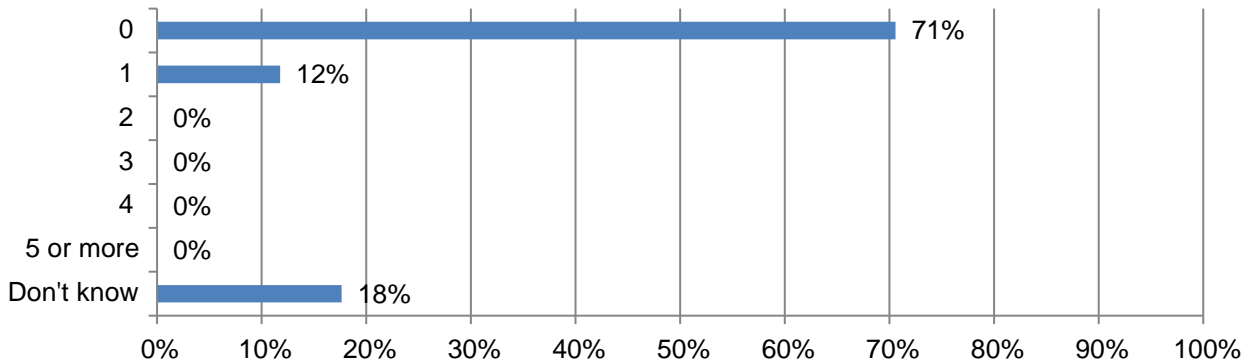

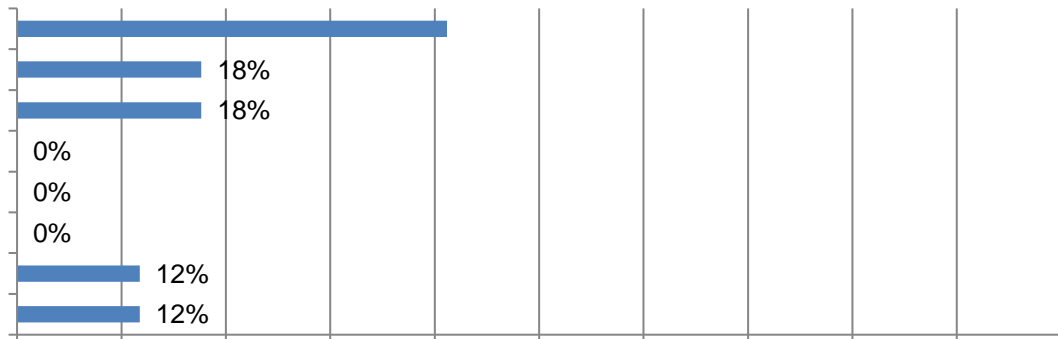
4. How many drivers or passengers were injured in these crashes? (269 Responses)
